CONTINUING TO BUILD

This is the third installation of quarterly caseload and time reporting prepared by the Department of Indigent Defense Services (DIDS).

As required by the Stipulated Consent Judgment in the case of *Davis v. State*, these reports include: public defense caseload numbers; attorney, staff, investigator, and expert hours spent per case; motion work; number of trials over the reporting period; and private workload. In evaluating the data contained herein, it is important to view these reports in the context that the timekeeping data is likely under-reported in some instances. There are several factors contributing to this assumption. The primary feedback DIDS has received from across the state is that – due to the size of their caseloads – practitioners must prioritize the practice of law and their clients' needs over entering this data. In any case, there has been both a learning and an implementation curve. Each quarter, the reports are looking better, and as compliance becomes mandated by new contracts, there is every reason to believe this trend will continue.

This report is more than just numbers and totals, however. It is the foundation for us to build quality, equitable, and sustainable indigent defense systems that strengthen local communities and guarantee constitutional protections for all of us.

In other words, this data is not just about complying with the reporting requirements of *Davis*. It is about creating information that provides previously unavailable pictures of how hard public defenders across the state are working and under what circumstances. With this information, DIDS can create a more robust and effective system with more access to resources for all Nevada communities.

And we are still at the beginning. Working together with our growing network of qualified indigent defense providers across the state, we will continue to make Nevada's communities stronger, more resilient, and better equipped for the future.
